 - Student and 3rd party(s) have provided documentation that supports the continuation of Title IV aid.
 1. Signed statement from student explaining why they failed to earn academic credit and confirms they did not enroll to only receive a credit balance.
 2. Obtained 3rd Party documentation to support the student's claim.
 - Student did not earn academic credits or clock hours based on documentation provided. It has been determined the student is not eligible for Title IV assistance and has been provided the necessary steps required to appeal the decision in order to regain eligibility.
 - Student's appeal was granted and will be allowed to complete the necessary steps as determined by the school to regain eligibility. Once the requirements have been met, we will resubmit the student's request for Title IV aid. **(File is considered incomplete until further notice.)**
