- 5. Lots A, C, and E be designated as Faculty/Staff/ commuter/guest parking only
- 6. Lot H be designated as faulty/staff and commuter only
- 7. Triplex and fourplex lots be designated for residential students only
- 8. All lots to be color coded with codes to match parking stickers
- 9. Color-coded signs to be erected in each lot for easy identification
